Ockbrook School Celebrates Top Class GCSE Results

Ockbrook School has sustained its position amongst the highest achieving schools in the region with pupils and staff celebrating the news that **58%** of Year 11 pupils achieved A*/A grades in their GCSEs.

83% of Year 11 pupils have achieved A* to B grades in their GCSEs and **24%** of students achieved all A*/A grades including: Selina Badiani, Holly Barker, Harriet Buckley, Zoe Carrigan, Siobhan Collins, Marianne Evans, Amelia Kenyon, Natasha Wrzesinski, Ayesha Shajpal and **Holly Edmond who gained 10 A* grades.**

97% of pupils achieved all A* to C grades with **100%** gaining A* to C in English and **98%** achieving A* to C in Maths.
